

I also give to my wife the house and land I now live on and
six negro men named Leham among the remainder my wife
and at her death or marriage the trustee to my son Bruth
and the Negro Leham to my son William I also give my
wife half the sheep and all my hogs with twenty barrels
of Corn & fowls enough to support her stock for the winter
It is my will and desire that the plantation may not be
rented or leased out

Now I give to my grandson Benjamin Hudson Apau
one Negro man named Lech and my riding horse to him
and his heirs forever all the rest of my Estate is to be
equally divided between my wife and my son William
this being my last will and Testament as witnessed my
hands this eight day of October one thousand eight hundred
and seven

I appoint William Hudson
Bruth Hudson & Samuel T. Hudson
Executors of this my last will & Testament

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And I give not any thing more to my 2^d Daughter Elizabeth
 she having already received her full proportion.

I give to my Daughter Betty E. Manning, a plain Gold
 Ring & not any thing ^{else} she also having received already her
 full proportion in. The balance of my Estate of every kind
 whatsoever not previously devised I give to my beloved wife
 during her natural life and at her ^{last wishes} death to be equally
 divided amongst my four sons to wit Benjamin & Stephen
 Richard & Joseph John F. Apice & Joseph F. Apice, the
 Survivors or their legal representatives.

Lastly I constitute & appoint my ready beloved wife
 Elizabeth Executrix & my ^{four sons} Benjamin & Stephen
 to this my Last Will and Testament they (meaning my sons)
 to qualify and act when they arrive to the age of Twenty
 one years. In Testimony whereof I have subscribed the same
 with own hand and caused my name to be witnessed this
 ninth day of March eighteen hundred & Eight.
