 down hundred dollars which is due me from my brother John there as will
 appear from his Bond bearing date 15 day of May 1816 to him John there for
 2nd I now and legally make my brother John there from hundred dollars
 which he is owing of me as will appear from his bond bearing date the 15th
 Feb'y 1816. I hereby appoint my brother Washington Care & place
 there my Executors to this Will having reached all others. In Witness
 whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 10 day of December 1816

At a Court of Monthly Session held for the County of Henrico
 in Monday the 27th day of January 1817. This Will was this day pre-
 sented in Court and proved by the Oath of William H. Collett and John deary
 the Witnesses thereof and here is attested the Executors thereunto to qualify them
 as such. At a Court of Monthly Session held for the said County of Henrico on
 Monday the 27th day of February 1817. This Will was this day again presented
 in Court and on the motion of Washington there an Executor thereunto in-
 -vited who made Oath thereof as the Law directs and entered into and acknow-
 -ledged Bond in the penalty of Four thousand six hundred dollars with John
 there his Surety conditioned as the Law directs. Certificate is granted him for
