Swanson with the one third of all my other property to her and here leave forever their Lands to be laid off in such a manner as to give my daughter Peggy Thomson the plantation where on I now live I do appoint Mariah Twiggler my Executor of this my last will and Testament reaching all other wills or wills by me made In witness whereof I have set my hand and prefix my seal this 22 day of May one thousand eight hundred twenty three.
