

In the Name of God. Amen.
I Richard Chandler of the County of Surrunna being not
in bodily health but of perfect sense and Memory have made
this my last Will and Testament in manner and form follow-
ing viz, Item I desire that my beloved wife Elizabeth Chandler
have the use of all my Estate except my Negro fellow Jeffery
two Hephers and two Eves and Lumbos which I shall hereafter
dispose of otherwise, during the time she may remain my Wi-
dow, and in case she marries then the whole of the said Estate
that may be in ^{her} possession to be equally divided between her and
each of my Younger Children begotten by ^{her} (namely) Richard
Nancy John Robert George and Lucy or among such of them
as may be surviving at the time of such division and if any of
those my said Children before named should die without
Heir or before they come of Lawfull age that their part of said
Estate shall be equally divided among those still surviving.
Item I also give and bequeath unto my two Daughters
Elizabeth Chandler and Thamar Chandler my Negro fellow
Jeffery to be equally divided between them on the 25th day
of December in the ^{year} 1785 and that the said Negro Jeffery be
hired Yearly for the best price untill the said period 1785
doth arrive and that the Money arising from such Hire shall be
equally divided between my Widow and two Daughters Elizabeth

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any time
one Hephers and one Eve and Lumb to be delivered when demanded
by her. I likewise give unto my Daughter Thamar Chandler one Hephers
and one Eve and Lumb to be delivered when demanded by her. I also direct
that if after all my Accounts be collected and payments made towards
paying all my just debts I should still be indebted that the whole of
my Estate disposed of among my Widow and Children shall pay a
proportionable part of the same debt that I may still justly owe. Lastly
I appoint and constitute my beloved wife Executrix ^{her} ^{of} Thomas Ma-
pier and Sackville King my Executors to this my last Will and Tes-
tament, allowing and conforming the same and discharging all
others whatsoever. In Witness whereof I have set my hand and
Seal this 26th day, October 1781.

what is usual in such cases, Certificate is granted him for obtain-
