will and Testament in manner and form following suprampus I give
to any Daughter Anna and Maria, One Negro girl each one feather bed
and furniture one cow and Calf, one Ox and Lamb to each to be deli-
vered by my Executors at their Marriage so as they arrive to lawful age
Item I lend unto my beloved wife Mary Shepherd the Plantation
and Land wherein I now live except my son Augustine Shepherd shalld

is my will that place to be sold for him is as near to interfere with the planta-
tion by my executors in case for him to purchase land in that Country

With all my Stock of Horses, Cows hogs and Sheep to be by her freely enjoyed
as also my household and Kitchen furniture Plantation and Black Smiths Tools
during her natural life, and the whole of my Negroes except one to each of two
Daughters as is before mentioned Item I give to my son John Shepherd after
the division of my Estate the sum of Forty one Pounds eight shillings more
than an equal part with the rest of my Sons Item I give and bequeath
unto my daughter Anna Shepherd one London Saddle and bridle to be
delivered to her by Executors when called upon to her and her heirs forever
Item if my son Augustine Shepherd should choose to live on the land
whereon I now live I give and bequeath the same to him after the
Death of above one hundred and fifty acres to be laid off at the lower part
of my land including all Hovens to him and his heirs forever
Item I also give and bequeath to my son Augustine when he arrives to
lawful age One feather bed and furniture One Cow and Calf and one
Mans Saddle to be delivered to him by my Executors to him and his heirs
forever Item I give and bequeath to my daughters after the death of my
wife Mary Perry, Elizabeth Cook Joanna and Anne fifty Pounds current money
Money to each to be raised out of my Estate by my executors to them and
their heirs forever Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Lucy ten
one Negro girl named Lucy now in her possession also I give to my wife Mary
less after the death of my wife fifty Pounds current Money to be raised out of
my Estate by my Executors to her and her heirs forever Item I give to my
daughter Frances Bassett the Land whereon she now lives to be enjoyed by
her and her heirs forever Item it is my will and desire if after all my
just debts are paid there should be any remainder either by will bond or other
wise the same be equally divide amongst all my children or their legal
Representatives. Item it is my will and desire that if either of my children
should die not having lawful issue or Representatives of Children Alive
at that time of his or her death, that then and in that case all and every
part or parts of my Estate hereby given to them or either of them shall revert
to the surviving Brothers and Sisters or their legal Representatives.
