At a Court held for Fluvanna County on Thursday the 1st day of June 1789 This Writing was this day produced in Court and proved to be the last Will and Testament of Thomas Bailey by the oaths of Isaac Bryant, Thomas Bailey Junr, and David Shepherd the witnesses thereto, and ordered to be recorded and Time is allowed the Executor therein named to qualify to this Will. And also Court held for Fluvanna County the 3rd day of September in the year afterward The Executor named in this Will refusing to take upon themselves the burthen of the Execution thereof On the motion of Charles Bailey and no taking the oath appointed by Law, and entering into Bond, with his Brother Bailey his Security in the penalty of one hundred pounds conditioned as the Law directs; Certificate is granted him for holding the office of Executor to all and singular the Goods, Chattels and Credits of Thomas Bailey dec'd with the Will annexed, in due form.
