apart of the tract I live on to be laid off at the lower end of said tract,

forever. Item I give unto my son Thomas O Hendley one hundred
Acres of Land being a part of the tract I live on to be laid off at
the upper end joining the Fluvanna River and the lines of
Capt John Ware. Also I give to my son Thomas O. Ten Pounds burnt
money to be paid him when he shall come to the age of twentyone
years, as also one feather Bed and Bed clothes, a hat and saddle to be
of the Value of twelve Pounds to him and his Heirs forever.

Item I give unto my son Caleb ninety five Acres of Land it being
the remainder of S. Tract to join the Fluvanna River & Drims branch
give unto my son Caleb ten Pounds burnt money to be paid him when
he shall come to the age of twentyone years as also one Feather Bed
and Bed clothes, a hat and saddle to be worth twelve Pounds to
him and his heirs forever. Item I give unto my son Hyezhiah
one acre of Land which acre I reserved out of the Tract, to be
to him and his heirs forever. Item I give unto my son William
one shilling and three pence burnt money to him and his heirs
forever. Item I give unto my son in Law Charles Johnson
one shilling and three pence burnt money to him and his heirs forever.
Item I lend unto my Daughter Mildred her own one Horse, one
Bed and Bed clothes during life and at her decease to be to her
heirs forever. Item I give unto my Daughter Mildred one Horse, one
Bed and Bed clothes during life and at her decease to be to her
heirs forever.
