The fifth day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety four I William Ames in the County of Fluvanna being very sick and weak in Body but of perfect mind and memory thanks be given unto God for the same and calling to mind the mortality of my Body and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament that is to say principally and first of all I give and recommend my soul into the hands of God that gave it and for my Body I recommend to the

care of such worthy Estate whomever it has pleased God to bestow on me in this life I give devise and dispose of the same in the manner and form following that is to say In the first I give and bequeath to Askin Martin all my clothes be them more or less also I give to Askin Martin one tract of Land lying in Yorkland bound by my Eighty nine acres be the same more or less. I do ratify and confirm this to be my last Will and Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the day and year above Written
