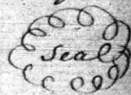

In the name of God amen I Alexander Rep of Franklin County State of Virginia being in perfect health and sound of memory thanks be to Almighty God calling to mind the mortality of my body and knowing it is appointed for all men to die do make and Ordain this my Last Will and Testament that is to say first of all I give and recommend my soul to Almighty God that gave me and my body to the earth to be decently buried at the Discretion of my Exec^r hoping that at the General Resurrection to receive it again by the mighty power of God, and as touching my worldly Estate that has pleased God to bless me in this life I give and dispose of the same in following manner. First of all after my Just debts and funeral Expences be paid I leave I leave unto my beloved Wife Mourning Rep my Estate of cattle hogs horses Sheep and all other things belonging to be hers during her life or Widowhood and after her death or marriage that then my whole Estate Except Land to be sold and Equally divided amongst my Eight children namely David Rep my son I give one piece of Land call^d Adams Elizabeth Rep Franky Rep Jean Goodman Rep Nancy Rep

Susannah Rop. James Rop. George Lockwood Rop. I give unto him the Land whereon I now live, to take possession when of age, to be done by my Exec^r. Lastly I appoint Maj^r John Smith and Zachariah Jones my sole and sole Executors to this my Last will and Testament, In Witness whereof I have set my hand and fixed my seal this 8th day of January

I Robert Napier of the County of Franklin State of Virginia being a weak body though of sound mind and memory, calling to mind the mortality of my body, and knowing that it is appointed to all men once to die, have made & executed this my Last Will and Testament, wherein first of all I recommend my Soul into the hands of Almighty God who gave it, and my body at my decease to be Decently Interred at the Discretion of my Executors hereafter mentioned, And Touching those worldly goods, whereunto it hath pleased God to bless me with, I give and dispose of in manner and form following Viz^t First of all I lend unto my beloved Wife Elizabeth Napier during her Widowhood my house & plantation whereon I now live, and four Negroes by the names of Peter Sarah Judith & Joe likewise my household goods and stock of all kind, during her continuance as above Stated - And after her decease or marriage my desire is that the two Negroes Joe and Sarah should fall into the hands of my two sons Moses & Champion Napier & Paul & John Napier as agents to my son James Napier & my
