desirous to Dispose of all such Worldly Estate as it hath pleased
God to bless me with, Do hereby make this my Last Will
and Testament, in the manner and form as followeth: In the
first place I desire that my Executors herein after named
shall after my Decease pay all my just Debts and Funeral
Expences; Item I give and bequeath to my Dearly beloved Wife
Elizabeth Kitterman the test of my Estate both Real and
personal during her natural Life, Except that part of my
Estate that I was entituled to from my Brother John George
Kitterman Deceased, which I have put in the hands of
John Fishburn & my son John Kitterman by a Deed of
Trust, which Estate I give and bequeath to my several Legatees
hereafter named, to be Equally divided amongst them provided
they shall give to my securities John Fishburn William Aker
& George Ferguson Bonds with sufficient securities to indemnify
them; It is my Will that if any of my Legatees hereafter
named except the Heirs of Michael Kitterman Deceased shall fail
to give their Bonds as aforesaid, shall have but one Dollar; It
is also my Will that if any of my said Legatees shall bring
any vexatious suits contrary to the Deed of Trust that I have
executed to John Fishburn & John Kitterman, that the cost
shall be taken out of the money that I have left to them by
Will, and given to them before Item I give to son Michael
