In the name of God amen I Charles Minnie of Franklin County and State of Virginia being thro the abundant mercy and goodness of God, tho weak in Body, yet of sound and perfect understanding and memory do constitute this my last Will and Testament and desire it may be received by all as such. First I most humbly bequeath my soul to God my maker beseeching his most gracious acceptance of it through the all sufficient merits and mediators of my most compassionate redeemer Jesus Christ who gave himself to be an atonement for my sins. Pled to God I give my body to the Earth from whence it was taken in full assurance of its Resurrection from thence at the last day, as for my Burial I desire it may be decent at the discretion of my dear Wife and Executor hereafter names, who I doubt not will manage it with all requisite prudence as to my worldly Estate. I will and positively order that all my Just debts be paid. First I give to my dear ^{and} loving wife Rachel for the term of her life the plantation and house I now live in with all the household and Kitchen furniture, also one Bay horse one barrel Mare one yearling Colt and all the farming utensils of every description, also all the stock of cattle and hogs, I give to my Daughters Susie and Rachel each of them a Bed and bedding and if they marry each of them to get a horse, I give to my son Daniel one young barrel Mare, My son Abner if he stays and helps to take care of his Mother until he is twenty one, I allow him a horse and if his Mother should die before he arrives at twenty one I will him one horse and if he want be ruler I will that he be bound to a trade

93. that he beareth, and Daniel takes care of his Mother
until she dies, I am my Executors and Executrix to make
him a reasonable allowance ~~for~~ his share I will and order
at my Wife Decase that there be sale of the land and all
property of every Description, and an equal Division made
among my Children, excepting 13 Dollars I allow John
more than his share Caly, Hugh, John, Jesse, Sicily, Mary,
Daniel, Rachel, Abner, Charles. Minnie & I will have one
Dollar. And do constitute Thomas Williams and Rachel
my Wife Executors and Executrix of this my last Will and
Testament and trustees for my Children in Witness whereof
I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 5th day of June 1811.
