In the name of God Amen I Christian Black of Franklin County
and State of Virginia being weak of body but of desperate mind
and memory being desirous to dispose of such things as it has
pleased God to bless me with do make my will and Testament
in the following manner To wit, first I desire that all my
lawful debts be paid, second I give unto my son ^{and daughter} ~~Black~~ the
land whereon my son John now lives, John to have one hundred acres
including the buildings at five Dollars per acre and Samuel Black
seventy five acres at three Dollars per acre I give unto my son
Michael Black one hundred and fifty acres including the old
plantation and buildings at five Dollars per acre, I give unto my
son Jacob Black 75 acres at the upper end of my land at three
Dollars per acre and the said Michael Black is to furnish his
father and mother with what grain and meat and necessaries
of life that they may want at the market price which is to come
out of the price of his land willed to him and to furnish
them with two cows while they may be able to live and to furnish
them with food and if any of them should be the longest time then he
is to furnish one cow in the same manner, and the said

586 Michael Black is to make a fire place in the Old house and to let
his father and mother have it during death or either of their lives
and the said John and Michael Black is to pay all my debts
and is together with what I owe them and what Michael
may furnish me or his mother to be taken out of the price of ~~the~~
lands and the balance including the price of Land willed to Samuel
& Jacob Black shall be equally divided between my Sons and Daughters
that is to say, John Black, Michael Black, Samuel Black, Jacob
Black, Susanna Cussett, Elizabeth Akers & Mary Black and the
said Christian Black and his wife is to have privilege to make
use of what fruit they may want for their own use and Cattle
I appoint my wife and Samuel Montgomery and John Barnhart
executors and executors to this my last will and Testament

17th day of April 1823
