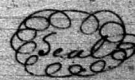

Secondly, I will and lend to my beloved wife Milly all my Estate both real & personall during her natural life, for her to enjoy the same. Thirdly and lastly, at the Death of my beloved wife Milly I do give and Bequeath unto my son Ezekiel all my Estate that is in my possession both real and personall, to be his own right & property for ever and do hereby constitute and appoint my son Ezekiel Clay Executor of this my last Will and Testament, hereby revoking all other former Wills, or Testaments by me heretofore made.
