Then I give Devise and Bequeath unto my Son George his Heir
and Assigns the Plantation he now lives on beginning his mother
Ten Bushels of Wheat Every year and I give him one quarter
of an Acre of Flax and One half Acre of Corn to be Every
Year likewise to keep his Two Cows and one Horse. I give
I do make him a Deed for his Land. Then I give Devise &
Bequeath unto my Son John his Heir and Assigns my Plantation
in Bolivar County on the Waters of Little River, likewise I will
that when the Plantation I now live on is Sold if there is any Thing
to be Paid on it it is then to be Paid for him. Then I give and
Bequeath unto my Daughter Hannah one Black mare & Colch
Then I give & Bequeath unto my Daughter Elizabeth one
Young Horse. Then I give and Bequeath unto my Daughter
Mary one Young Black mare. Then I give & Bequeath unto
my loving wife & her the Plantation I now live on with all the good
Chattell & other Moveables and Debts and what all Debts and do
constitute his Executors, of his my last Will & Testament I do
Witness at my House hereunto. At my hand and Seal this Twenty
Second Day of August in the Year of our Lord first one
