of an Acre of Land and give fifty Pounds of Cakes to his Son
John to keepe to keep his Two Cows and one horse of John Mopring
to make him a Dred for his Land. Item I give Demise &
Bequest unto my Son John his Heirs and Assigns my Plantation
in Boketown Lately on the Waters of the River, likewise I desire
that when the Plantation there lies on is sold if there is any Thing
left Paid and it is then left to land for him. Item I give and
Bequest unto my Daughter Hannah an Black mare & colt
Item I give of Bequest unto my Daughter Elizabeth an
Young horse. Item I give and Bequest unto my Daughter
Mary and Young Black mare. Item I give of Bequest unto
my loving wife of the Plantation I now live on with all the goods
belonging thereto and Belonging thereto and do
Command her Exercising of this my last Will & Testament In
