 her natural life and at her death my will and desire is that
 it should be disposed of in the following manner that is to say
 my Executors whithin after named shall sell all my Lands
 and make Decr to the same and also all my property of what
 soever kind and to divided a moost my wholding equally
 that is to say Elizabeth Peters, John Good, David Good, William
 Good, Jacob Good & Samuel Goods Decr here except fifty Dollars
 which the said Peters has Recd in advance.
