In the name of God Amen I David Perquin of the County of Franklin and State of Virginia Being in a good State of health but of sound memory I make and ordain this my Last Will and Testament in the following manner (to wit) first and Primarily that my Just Debts be paid secondly I Will & bequeath unto my beloved Wife Susanah Two Wheals one Dutch oven & Skillet & one large Kettle to be sold at her own Disposal I also leave my Land to her with all my Plantation Tools necessary for Raising a crop in order to support her self & Raise the Child with all my house furniture only what shall be hereafter Excepted for my Daughter Joanna it is my souls desire that Susanah my Wife enjoy the above privileges till her death or marriage. my meaning is if she marries she is to take her thirds of the remaining part of my Estate besides what I have above Bequeathed to her and all the ballance my Estate both Real & personal I give and bequeath unto my beloved Daughter Joanna The same is to be observed at the death of my Wife as at her marriage that is the whole of my Estate to return to my Daughter Joanna. I also give to my Daughter Joanna one copper Tea Kettle Brass warming Pan Pepper Mill small Trunk large Bed Sheet Two Pillow cases large Diaper Table cloth Two large
