 Likely Boies and Purchase her a Woman Saddle worth four Pounds Ten
 Shillings also one feather Bed and furniture I also Give unto my Daughter
 Fanny Estes my Negro Girl named Lucy to her and the Lawful heirs of

for Body for ever, Also I give unto my Daughter Mary Fuller one Shely Cow & half
out of the Stock Lent my Wife as above Item my will and Deane is after the Decease
of my Beloved wife that my Two Negroes ^{my} Dancie & Grace and his increase with all
my household furniture Beds Goods Crops &c. that then shall or may Remain be Equally
Divided amongst my Dear Children hereafter mentioned Vt. Dce Bente Keziah
Merby Elizabeth Anglin Fanny Estes Elisha Estes Bottom Estes Asa Estes and
Jesse Estes or their heirs only it is to be Observed that my sons Elisha & Bottom
Estes are to render an Account in Writ of what Stock and furniture they have
Received from me heretofore that all my sons may be Equal, Item I give unto my
sons Asa Estes and Jesse Estes all the Land Snow Shoe upon containing Three hundred
acres to be Equally Divided after my Wifes Decease to them and the heirs of
their Body for ever, Lastly I constitute and appoint my Loving wife Francis Estes
my Dear son Bottom Estes and my well Beloved friends Frederick & Peves and
Samuel Galland the Executors of this my Last Will and Testament, Given under
