Report of John S Burwell one of the Commissioners appointed by an order of the said Court, bearing date on the day of Commissioners and directing him, or the other Commissioners or both of them to proceed to sell at Publick Auction the Estate of Elisha Estes lately in the possession of his Widow Frances James did proceed on the 25th day of March.

in conformity to the said order to sell the same, consisting of sundry articles an Account whereof is herewith returned together with the amount for which each Article sold, and the name of the purchaser which is prayed to be considered as a part of this his report. Your Commissioner also further reports, that he has taken Bonds with such security as he approved from the purchasers for the amount of the sums they were respectively indebted which he has here in Court, subject to be disposed of in such manner as the Court may direct. That the sum of twenty one Dollars was paid in money at the time of the sale

and is subject to the order of the court. Your Commissioner further reports, that he became the purchaser of one of the Negroes at the price of Eight hundred and twenty one Dollars for which sum no Bond was given, he not knowing to whom it should be Decuted, and is ready to Decute one according to the terms of the sale, save to any person the court may designate for that purpose.
