Elisha in his last Illness. Said in our presence, his conversation
Will &c addressed to his Mother and us the Subscribers, on the 26th
Examined day of December 1815 that he should die in a short time
perhaps in the course of three or four weeks that after his
death he wished his brother William Simmons to have all his
Estate upon this condition that he gave to his youngest
Brother Thomas Simmons two years schooling if he
