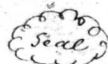
In the name of God Amen I Elizabeth Harris of Franklin County
being in perfect health and sound memory do make this my Last
Will and Testament in the manner and form as followeth (Viz),
In the first place my Will and desire that all my Just Debts be
paid my body decently buried and Funeral Expenses discharged
out of my Estate; Then with respect to the rest of my Worldly
Estate I bequeath and give In primis, to my Son John Harris
five pounds that is in his hands to him and his heirs forever, unto
my Daughter Susannah Dipp my Negro Agg to her and her heirs
forever; unto my Daughter Elbow Gutherie my Negro Kate,
Joan and Hannah to her and her heirs forever with all their Increase,
but if my said Daughter just mentioned make any claim or demand
by her heir or heirs for any part of her fathers Estate, or any negro's
money ^{what} she has already got, then my Will is that my Daughter
Anne Estes shall have Kate, Joan, and Hannah and their
Increase to her and her heirs forever. I give to my Daughter Sarah
Bennett my Negro Sam and her Increase from this date to her &
her heirs forever, also one Feather Bed she has now in her hands
I give to my Daughter Anne Estes my Negro Isaac, also my
Negro Sam to her and her heirs forever. ^{all the money} I
may have or should or may at my Death I leave in the hands
of Joel Estes for him to collect and pay what may be due by me
at that period, the Rest he is to keep for what Trouble he has &
may be at for me. Also I now confirm unto him all that Ever
I gave him formerly. And I now by these presents do constitute
and appoint Joel Estes, Daniel Let my whole and Sole Ex^r
of this my Last will and Testament. Signed seal & Executed this seventh
day of January one thousand seven hundred & ninety five

Also my Will and Desire that Joel Estes should have all the hire
that is due me from my son John Harris for the use and labour of
one Negro Lad named James & asert this to be our bargain for the
first year he was to give me Twenty Barrels of Corn for my

after the first year my said son John Harris was to give me what I thought was reasonable, and to pay me in the Store, or in any way I would call for it, Cash, Corn or Tobacco till the said Negro James was sold for by me or my order. Whereas I have given Ann Estes & Joel Estes her husband the Just right and title to the said Negro James with the hies which I think five pounds a year is little enough for every year since the first year. As Witnesseth my hand and seal this thirteenth day of March one thousand seven hundred & ninety five

Theodorick Webb of Franklin County State of Virginia being very infirm in body - but of perfect memory & disposing memory, do make and ordain this my last Will & Testament in manner herein following to wit - my soul I humbly offer to Almighty God who gave it; and my body I wish to be decently buried at the discretion of my beloved Wife Sarah Webb who I hereby constitute & appoint my sole & only Executrix. And as to my Worldly Estate with which it has pleased God to bless me, It is my Will and desire that the same both real and personal be kept together & carried on in the same manner that it is now carried on by me, until my youngest Child arrives to the age of twenty one years old; and that the profits arising from the same over & above what shall be found necessary for the decent and genteel support of my family without Extravagance, be carefully placed out at interest, and it is my Will and desire that my ^{beloved} Wife Sarah Webb have the direction & management of my Estate to be carried on
