In the name of God Amen. I Faithful Luke of
Franklin County and State of Virginia, being weak of body
but of perfect mind & memory thanks be to almighty God
for his mercies, therefore calling to mind the mortality of my
body and knowing that it is appointed for all men once for
to die, do make and ordain this my Last Will and testament
that is to say principally and first of all I give and recommend
my soul into the hands of God who gave it, as for my body
I do commend it to be buried in a Christian manner by my
executors hereafter mentioned, nothing doubting but at the
general resurrection I shall receive the said again by the
mighty power of God, as touching such worldly goods
belonging to my estate, wherewith it has pleased God to
bless me with in this life. I Give Bequeath and devise
in the following manner. First I do give and
bequeath unto my son John Luke one negro Boy named
Frank, likewise one Negro Boy named Tom, likewise 1 Negro
Girl named Patsy, I likewise Give & Bequeath unto my
son William Luke 1 Negro Boy named William likewise
1 Negro Woman named Rose likewise 1 Boy named
William son of Rose & likewise one named Jeph I Give
& Bequeath unto my Daughter Betsey Guithams unto the
heir of her body 1 Negro Woman named Biddy likewise 1
Negro Girl named Molly likewise 1 Negro Girl named Phillis
I likewise Give & bequeath unto my son John Luke & William
Luke one hundred & fifty four acres of Land situated one Chertut
Joining Elijah Warrers Line to be Equally Divided Between
them I likewise do appoint Daniel Nickerson and Edmund
Fate my Executors to this my Last Will & Testament and
I do revoke, disallow all other former Wills & testaments, Legacies
Bequeaths Executors By me in any wise before this named
Will, & Bequeathed ratifying & confirming this and no other
to be my Last Will & testament In Witness whereof I have
hereunto set my hand and Seal this twenty third Day of
January in the Year of our Lord 1813.
