In conformity to an Order of the Court of Franklin to us directed, we have attested and laid out to Elizabeth Nauhaus (Widow of George Sprangler deceased here deceased in 708 Acres of land whereof the said George Sprangler was possessed at the time of his death, as designated in the Plat marked N^o 1. The residue of which land we have divided amongst the legates of the said George Sprangler deceased, according to Quantity and Quality, by marked lines, to Nancy Sprangler the Sole designated in the connected plat, as the north Lot, and marked N^o 2. To Phelu Sprangler the Sole designated in the said plat, as the East Lot, and marked N^o 3. To George Sprangler the Sole designated, the Sole designated in the said Plat as the West Lot and marked N^o 4. To Mary Sprangler now the wife of Allen Farret the Sole designated in the said plat as the South Lot and marked N^o 5. Given under our hands this 3^o day of March 1806.
