Agreeable to an order of our the County Court of Franklin bearing date the 10th day of August 1820 to us directed, we have laid off, and apportioned to Happay Pardue, Widow and Relict of Daniel Pardue Deceased one third of the Land, which the said Daniel Pardue Died in possession of, which said Dower contains _____ Acres of Land and bounded as followeth to wit, Beginning at a poplar on a branch in Meshack Pardue's line thence south 70 East 16 poles to a Hickory North 73 East 28 poles to a Red Oak, North 30 poles to a hohnut on the said branch, thence down the same as it measures to the River, thence up the same as it measures to Meshack Pardue's line thence thence with various courses thereof to the beginning. Given under our hands this 7th day of Sept 1820.

I, Nancy Richardson of Franklin County and State of Virginia, do hereby make my last Will and Testament in the manner and form following that is to say. First I desire that all of the perishable part of my Estate be immediately sold after my death or so much thereof as will pay all of my Debts and funeral expences and if any left ^{to be left} as I shall direct here after, secondly I give to my Mother Phanny Richardson all of my perishable property that is left after paying all of my just debts and funeral expences, also the Tract of Land, which I now live on, to be left entirely at her own disposal as long as she lives and at her death to Will and dispose of the Land and property as she thinks proper.
