 of Franklin County we have this 28th day of January 1811
 proceeded to lay off and assign to Mary Doran the widow
 of Hartman Doran Dec^d, her Dower in Land and
 Negroes to wit.

Beginning on the north side of the Land at the back line
 at a Spanish and White Oak from thence S 11th Degrees W
 32 poles to a Spanish Oak stump thence N 10 20 poles
 to an apple Tree thence S 34th W 18 poles to a crooked apple
 Tree thence 13 W. 30 poles to a Locust on the south side

of the Branch thence up the said Branch as it meanders to the mouth of the falling rock Branch thence up the falling rock Branch to the back line) all the Land lying on the West side of the said line together with the mansion house is allotted to the said Mary Doran also the negro woman Peggy that composes lot N^o 1 is chosen by her to be her Dower in the Slaves
