Then I give to my Daughter Rebecca Jones two Dollars to be paid out
of my Estate she also having been previously provided for by me
Then I give my son A. Agre One hundred acres of Land, it being a portion
of a part of the tract of Land on which I now live the my late son A.
having been provided with other property. Then I give to my Daughter Polly
Eighty One hundred acres of Land on which she now lives the also
having rec^d other property. Then I give to my son Levi Agre, One
hundred acres of Land on which he now lives of other property he heretofore
Then I give to my son Matthew One hundred acres of Land which I have
already conveyed to him of being the said tract he sold to Garrett
P. other property he heretofore. Then I give to my son Asa One hundred
acres of Land on which I now live, also other property heretofore
