I Richard Stockton of the County of Franklin State of Virginia
being of sound disposing mind I mean and calling to mind that
it is appointed for all men to die, do hereby constitute this as
my last Will & Testament, Revoking all other Will or Wills by me
heretofore made First I recommend my Soul to God who gave it
existence and that my Body be decently buried at the discretion of my
Executors and Executors hereafter named. Item my Will and desire
is that all my just debts be paid also that my loving Wife Elizabeth
Stockton have the use and benefit of the Land and plantation
whereon I now live, including the Land I purchased of Samuel
Luttrell and Willis Luttrell with all the appurtenances therunto
belonging, also the following Negroes, namely, Simon and his wife
Aggy, and their daughter Amy, also Gilbert and Betty, with all
the Plantation Tools, household and Kitchen furniture
with all Stock of every kind, also my Mill except as hereafter
mentioned, all which I leave to my beloved wife during her
natural life. Item I give to my Daughter Elizabeth Copland the
Land I purchased of Dennis Marshall and the Title conveyed to me
by Elisha Arnold and Joseph Pezigo also a Negro Man named
David, which Land and Negro my said Daughter has already
in possession. Item I give to my Daughter Christiana King
Two Negroes namely Hercules and Edmund (which she has already
received). Item I give to my Daughter Nancy Wingfield the
following Negroes to wit. Sney and her two children named George
and Aggy, also a Girl named Sney, all of which she now
has in possession and with their future Increase. Item I give
to my Daughter Anna Craig two Negroes
