die do make & ordaine this my last will and Testament for the purpose
of Disposing my worldly goods in the following manner, My first
I Recommend my soul to the Care of god and my body to be buried
by my Executors at thier discretion. I direct that my funeral
Expences and lawfull debts be paid, Item, I give and bequeath
to my loving wife Sarah Ego all my Real and personal Estate during
her Widowhood, but if she my said wife should Marry then my
Executors shall Divide my Estate, as they shall thinke but for the
Entertainment of my Children, to wit, first I direct that my Wife shall
have one third of my Estate as the law Directs, Lastly I appoint
Constitute and ordain my Friends Thomas Thompson and Moses Greer
to be my Executors of this my last Will and Testament, and do
by these presents Revoke all other Wills and Testaments in
Writing whereof I have unto Set my hand and affixed my seal
this twenty first day, may one thousand seven hundred and
ninety seven.
