In addition to the above named agreement I give unto my beloved wife and her daughter Polly Riddle all my movable estate after my Death first all my lawful debts to be paid and funeral expenses I give to my wife and her daughter Polly W Wade all the household and kitchen furniture with all my stock of every description and all my farming tools of every description (I have devised of my personal estate to my wife and her daughter Polly W Wade for her support during life) As for my said I do
