I Ambrose Wood of the State of Virginia & County of Franklin being in perfect health of body, and of perfect mind, and memory, thanks be given unto God, calling unto mind the mutability of my body, and knowing that it is appointed unto all men once to die, do make and Ordain this my Last Will & Testament; that is to say, principally & first of all, I give and recommend my soul unto the hands of Almighty God that gave it, and my body I recommend to the Earth, to be buried in decent Christian burial at the Discretion of my Executors, nothing doubting but at the general resurrection, I shall receive the same again by the mighty power of God, and touching such Worldly Estate wherewith it has pleased God to bless me in this life, I demise and dispose of the same in the following manner & form, First I give and Bequeath to Elisabeth my dearly beloved Wife whom I likewise constitute make & Ordain, the sole Executrix of this my Last Will & Testament, all singular my household goods & furniture & whatever else I possess, by her freely to be possessed & enjoyed or disposed of at her Will, I also give & bequeath unto my son Peter Wood one dollar, And I do hereby utterly disallow, revoke & disannul all and every other Testaments, Wills, legacies, bequests, & Executors by me in any wise before named, Willed & bequeathed, ratifying & confirming this & no other, to be my Last Will & Testament.
