And on the motion of John Craghead and Robert Craghead the Executors herein named, who made oath as the Law directs, and together with Isiah Craghead, James L. Nail and George Radford their securities entered into and acknowledged their Bond in the penalty of four thousand pounds, conditioned as the Law directs certificate is granted them for obtaining a probat in due form.

Randolph & Henry after they pay my son Wyatt forty pounds.
