The last will and Testament of John Ritter who is weak in Body but in perfect sense & Memory first I recommend my soul to God who give it and my Body to be decently Buried not doubting but at the Resurrection I shall Receive the same by the Almighty power of God and as to my Worldly Estate I order it to be divided in the following manner, Viz, first it is my desire will that all my Just Debts and funeral Charges to be paid and I do order that my Wife & my have my whole Estate in her hands as long as she remains unmarried and I do order that my Mother may have her living out of my Estate as long as she lives I do make and Ordain my Wife & Jacob King to be my whole and sole Executors of this my Last will and Testament I hereby disallow Revock and every other will former Testament wills Agreements ratifying Confirming this and no other to be my Last will & Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 24th day of October 1793. kind seals Published and Pronounced in the presence of us &c
