In the name of God Amen, I John Thurmond of Franklin County Virginia being weak in body, but of sound mind and disposing memory, calling to mind the uncertainty of human life, and knowing it is Ordained for all men once to die, trusting in the mercies of God, do make this my last Will and Testament First I desire to be buried in Christian form, and also that all my just debts be paid, secondly I lend to my beloved wife during her natural life all my lands to be held occupied used and enjoyed by her, I also lend my beloved wife during her life one third of my household and Kitchen furniture and one third of my plantation utensils, I also give my said beloved wife one bay mare named scrug, one of my best cows and a calf the best sow & pigs in my stock, two killing Hogs, a black and a spotted, one supposed to weigh two hundred each & five head of sheep, but should she marry she is to have for life one third of my land only. All the rest of my personal property not lent or given as above to my beloved wife, Sarah, I direct may be sold and after paying my Debts Thirty Dollars are to be paid to my Grand Son Willers Wray, and thirty dollars to Polly Wray Daughter of Heziah Wray - now Heziah Holabron and the balance to be equally divided between my Daughters, Polly Wray & Locky Whitwood and my sons Henry Thurmond and Pleasant Thurmond share and share alike, and at the death of my wife I desire that my lands and the property lent my wife may be sold, and after paying my daughter Elizabeth Harrison the sum of eighty four dollars which is to be in full, the balance to be divided between my two sons Henry & Pleasant Thurmond and Polly Wray and Locky Whitwood, share and share alike, and if the said Henry & Pleasant, Polly & Locky, can agree on the dividing lines instead of selling they may divide the same without sale, and in the event of the said Henry or Pleasant, or said Polly or Locky's death then the lawful heirs of the one so deceased to come & stand in the place of the said dec^d and take such share as the dec^d would have taken had he lived, I furthermore direct out of crops I may leave on hand as much grain and rough feed may be given my beloved wife Sarah as may be sufficient to support the stock given her, and her household
