In the name of God Amen, I Dildale N Nicks of the County of Franklin State of Virginia, being weak of body and very sick but of perfect mind & memory, do constitute this my last Will & Testament hereby revoking all Wills by me heretofore made first, my Will and desire is that my body be decently buried, at the discretion of my Executor who shall be here after named secondly my Will & desire is that all my just debts be paid, and as to the worldly goods it has pleased God to bless me with, my Will and desire is that they be divided as follow (To-wit) first I give and bequeath to Miss Martha Gothard of this County two hundred and ninety Acres of Land which must be taken from a tract of land lying in Galtell County of this State on Clear Creek a branch of Guyandole containing One Thousand three hundred and ninety one Acres, be it understood that this above lot of Land must be larger or smaller to make it and the balance of s<sup>d</sup> Land equal proportionable to quantity, beginning on one side or end of said Land. Second I give and bequeath to Mr W. Eldridge one hundred Acres of Land to be taken from the above recited Tract of Land, and in the same manner as the above Sum. Thirdly I give and bequeath to my beloved brother Howard G Nicks, One Thousand and one Acres of Land the balance of the said Tract above recited Land lying in Galtell County Virginia, or Clear Creek a branch of Guyandole, I do hereby nominate, constitute and appoint my beloved Brother Howard G Nicks, Executor to the said last Will.
