In the name of God Amen, I William Hutcherson of Franklin County & State of Virginia being in a Low State of Health, though in sound mind & memory, and knowing it is allotted for all men once to Die do make & ordain this to be my last Will & Testament, hereby revoking all former Wills by me made, as follows, Viz, first, I give & bequeath unto my Father Matthew S. Hutcherson one Dollar & no more of my Estate in any manner. Secondly, I give & bequeath unto Elizabeth Early, Patsy Burton, Polly Rags & Sarah Hutcherson five Shillings each & no more my Estate. Thirdly, I give & bequeath unto Matthew Hutcherson Jun^r my horses saddle, and no more of my Estate. Fourthly, I give & bequeath unto Robert Pruitt Jun^r one hundred Dollars for his friendship & services to me to be paid to him by my Executor hereafter named as soon as the money can be raised by the hire of my negroes hereafter mentioned, without Interest thereon. Fifthly, I give & bequeath unto my nephew William Hutcherson son of my brother Matthew Hutcherson, my Negro man Daniel, also my Negro man Nelson to him and his heirs for ever, to be his own right & property for ever, and to receive possession of the same when he comes to the age of Twenty one years and till then my Negro Daniel to be hired out by my Executor hereafter named for the best price he can get, and in the second for my Negro Nelson to remain with my brother Matthew Hutcherson till my nephew William Hutcherson comes to the age of Twenty one years, upon his paying to my Executor fifteen Dollars for each year, and the hire of my negro Daniel & Nelson
