I Christina Kitterman of the County of Franklin and State of Virginia being ^{weak} in body but of sound mind disposing memory for which I thank God, and being conscious of the uncertainty of human life and being desirous of disposing of all such worldly Estate as it hath pleased God to bless me with do make this my Last Will & Testament, in manner and to wit as follows to wit: in the first place I desire after my decease that all ^{my} Last Debts & General Expenses shall honestly and punctually be paid by my Executors hereafter named. Now I desire that the Tole of my Estate both real & personal shall be equally divided amongst my Several Legatees hereafter named agreeable to the Last Will and Testament of Christopher Kitterman Dec^d 1777. And Lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint Lewis Davis and Robert Woods Executors of this my Last Will and Testament Revoking all and every other Will by me heretofore made, allowing this and no other to be my Last Will
