Ashworth In the name of God, Amen I John Ashworth of the County of John Franklin and State of Virginia, Being sick and weak in Body Will &c but of sound mind and disposing memory, for which I thank God, calling to mind the uncertainty of human life, and being desirous to dispose of all such worldly Estate as it hath pleased God to bless me with, I give and bequeath the same in manner following that is to say.

Item 1st I desire that All my Tobacco be Sold as soon as it can be made ready and removed to Market and out of the moneys arising from the sale thereof, all my just debts and funeral expences be paid, should my Tobacco prove insufficient for that purpose then I desire, that my Executors hereinafter named may sell so much of the same
