I give and bequeath to my well beloved son Moses Wray, Elijah Wray, John Wray, Wm Wray, Andrew Wray, Isaac Wray, all the Lands that I possess, except my wife Dowry or thirds, to be sold, and equally divided after the decease of my well beloved wife Elizabeth Wray, I also give and bequeath to my well beloved son James Wray ten shilling, and give and bequeath to my well beloved son Benjamin Wray ten shilling, also I give and bequeath to my well beloved son Daniel Wray ten shilling I also give and bequeath to my well beloved son Ezekiel Wray ten shilling, George Wray I give and bequeath ten shilling, I also give and bequeath to my well beloved Daughter Mary Wright ten shillings, also give I bequeath to my well beloved Tabitha Wright ten shilling, also give and bequeath to my well beloved Daughter Rebecca ten shilling, I also give and bequeath to my well beloved Daughter Margaret James ten shilling, I also give and bequeath to my well beloved Daughter Elizabeth Wray ten shilling, also I give and bequeath to my well beloved Daughter Geny Wray ten shilling I empower the above Executors to fullfill this my last Will and Testament I disannul all former Wills and Testaments whatsoever.
