In the name of God Amen I Owen Riddle of the County of Franklin and State of Virginia being sick and low of body but of sound mind and conscience calling unto mind the mortality of my body and that it is appointed for all men once to die do make & therewith last will and Testament as follows I give and bequeath to her my true wife Abby Riddle by her request all the Estate goods and chattels of every description whatsoever she was possessed of when I married her freely to be possessed and enjoyed by her and her heirs forever. In addition to the above named agreement I give unto my beloved wife and her daughter Polly Riddle all my movable estate after my Death first all my lawful debts to be paid and funeral expenses I give to my wife and her daughter Polly W Wade all the household and kitchen furniture with all my stock of every description and all my farming tools of every description (I leave domestic of my movable estate to my wife and her daughter Polly W Wade for her support during life) As for my slaves I leave

that my Executors sell the same for the best price they can get, ^{and make over the title} and
divide the money between my children equal with what they have
received hereof two survey wherein I was live one of One hundred
acres another appoyning the same of One hundred and twenty
another tract of forty in a cove of Nixel Not another tract of
43 appoyning appoyning the North side of Wilkins survey which survey
I have never had a Word but the proprietor Swinfield Ruble
gave me an endorcing bond so it may be sold with safety
I desire that the money arising for the sale of the same to be paid to my
Children Vizt Isaac Jones Thomas W Ruble, Elizabeth Hall Swinfield
Ruble, Marget Lanner Also I appoint William Jones & John Jones
my sole executors of this my last Will and Testament utterly disallowing
revoking and disannulling all other Wills legacies entered by me in
otherwise named Ratifying and confirm this and no other to be my last
will. In Witness I the said Owen Ruble have hereunto set my hand
and affixed my seal this sixth day of March One thousand eight
hundred and twenty four, and of the Commonwealth the forty eight
Published pronounced & declared by the said Owen Ruble ^{said}
to be his last will and Testament in presence of us

At a Court held for Charlottes County at the Courthouse the 6th day of December 1824

This last will and Testament of Owen Ruble deceased was produced
in Court by William Jones and John Jones the executors hereinafter named, and
proved by the Oath of John Hale and Jacob Troup two of the subscribing
Witnesses hereunto and Ordered to be recorded

And by the motion of the said William Jones and John Jones
who took the Oath prescribed by Law and together with Abraham Jones
and Robert Hamilton their securities entered into and acknowledged
their bond in the penalty of fifteen hundred Dollars, conditioned
according to Law certificate is granted them for obtaining a probat
thereof in due form
