Know all men by these Presents that we Peter Kingary Abraham Picklesman and William Atkins are held & jointly bound unto Hugh Jones Scireless Hill Nephew Green and Thomas Hale Gent. Justices now sitting in the sum of one hundred Pounds to which payment well and Truly to be made to the said Justices and their Successors we bind ourselves and each of us our and each of our heirs Executors and Administrators Jointly and Severally firmly by these Presents sealed with our seals and Dated this 7th Day of February 1791

The Condition of the above obligation is such that if the Above Bound Peter Kingary of all the Goods Chattels and Credits of Jacob Kingary Deceased do make or Cause to be made a Perfect Inventory of all and singular the Goods Chattels and Credits of the said Deceased which have or shall come to the hands Possession or Knowledge of the said Peter Kingary or into the hands or Possession of any Person or Persons for him and the same to made do Exhibit or Cause to be Exhibited into the County Court of Franklin at such time as shall be thereunto Required by the said Court, and the same Goods Chattels and Credits of the said Deceased at the time of his death or what at any time after shall come to the hands or Possession of any Person or Persons for him do well and Truly administer according to Law and further to make a Just and True Account of all Dealings and Doings therein when thereunto Required by the said Court and all the rest and residue of the said Goods Chattels and Credits which shall be found Remaining upon the said Administrators Account the same being first Examined and allowed by the Justices of the Court for the time being shall Deliver and pay unto such Person or Persons Respectively as the said Justices by their order or Judgment shall Direct Pursuant to the Law in that Case made and Provided, and if it shall hereafter appear that any Last will and Testament was made by the said Deceased and the Executor or Executors therein mentioned do Exhibit the same into the said Court making Request to have it allowed and Approved accordingly If the said Peter Kingary being thereunto Required to Render and Deliver up the Letter of Administration Approbation of such Testament being had and Made in the said Court then this obligation to be Void Else to remain in force
