Will and Testament that is to say principally and first of all I give and
bequeath my soul unto the hands of God that gave it and my body I recommend
to the Earth to be buried in decent Christian Burial at the discretion of
my Executors and as touching such worldly Estate wherewith it has pleased
God to bless me with I give and devise and dispose of the same in the following
manner and Form. First I give and Bequeath to Magdaline my dearly beloved
wife an Equal third part of my Estate both Real and personal, also I give unto
my sons John and Stephen Peters the balance of my Lands by their paying
unto Elizabeth Sarah & Jacob Ten pounds each also the said John & Stephen
is to have all my personal Estate after paying all my just debts also order
that my sons John and Stephen Peters be empowered to receive from Patrick
East and Jacob East the Balance of the purchase money of a tract of Land
sold to them in Montgomery County and to make them a good and lawful
Deed for the said Land so soon as they shall pay for the same and the money
received from them is to pay for the Land I bought of Jacob Kinsland Lastly
I appoint Michael Peters my Dear and beloved Brother Executor to this
my last Will and Testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set
my hand and seal this 15th day of November in the year of our Lord
one thousand Eight hundred and thirteen

Bond in the penalty of four hundred Dollars conditioned as the law
directs, certificate is granted him for obtaining a Probate, in due form
