I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Susannah Webster a negro girl by the  
name of Charlotte. I give her half my land my house household and kitchen  
furniture to be hers her lifetime and at her decease to be divided equally among  
my children all my other property I give and bequeath to my children namely  
Susannah Phillips Joseph Price <sup>one</sup> James Webster Samuel Webster Peter  
Webster Daniel Webster James Webster William C. Webster Polly <sup>eldest</sup>  
Reuben Webster Deborah Turner to be equally divided between each  
and every of them except James Webster who shall have twenty pounds  
more than the rest in addition whereof I hereby acknowledge this to be  
my last Will and Testament. A. B. I also desire my two eldest sons  
namely Samuel and Daniel Webster to be administrators on my Estate  
At the time of my birth the birth day of January in the year of our  
Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty three

read and proved by the Clerk of John Smith and Gabriel Wright the  
witnesses and ordered to be recorded.

This is to witness of Daniel Webster one of the executors herein named  
he took the Oath prescribed by Law and together with Daniel & Mrs  
William Webb and Thomas D. Green his securities entered into and  
acknowledged his bond in the sum of six thousand Dollars conditioned  
according to Law certificated is granted him for obtaining a Prost-  
thesis in due form liberty being reserved to Samuel Webster the  
other executor in the said will named to join in the Postal when  
he shall think fit
