 the view of the body of Anna Mars then & there lying dead & upon the
 oath of Alexander Leftwich Peter Booth, John Lagenburg, Levi Agre
 John Ferguson Thomas Adams, Thomas Johnson, James Wray, David
 Thompson Isaac Kraghead, Nathaniel Channing & Edmund
 Hatcher. Good & Lawfull men of the County aforesaid, who being
 sworn & charged to inquire on the part of the said Common Wealth, where
 where how & after what manner the said Anna Mars came to her Death
 Do say upon their Oaths that the said Anna Mars came to her Death
 by hanging herself with a Leather bridle by the neck in a cutting room
 adjoining a stable belonging to Thomas Hepinstall & that she must &
 did herself with her own hands tie the said bridle around a log
 suspended over the Room in which she was found hanging & with
 a Running noose of the other end of said bridle around her neck
 cheek & suffocate herself therewith, until dead, no other acts of
 Violence were discovered in the said Body in Witness whereof as well
 the said Bernard H. Hendrick JP as aforesaid as the Jurors aforesaid
 have to this Inquisition put their seals on the day & year aforesaid & at the
 place aforesaid

From the best wisdom that the
 Jury can obtain the said Anna
 Mars possessed no property but
 her wearing apparel
