to mind the mortality of my Body and knowing that it is once appointed for
all men once to die having made and ordained this my last will & Testament
wherein first of all I Recommend my soul in the hands of almighty gods who
gave it me, nothing doubting but at the General Resurrection I shall receive
the same by the mighty power of God and my body at my decease to be
Decently interred at the discretion of my Execut. and as Touching such worldly
goods wherein it hath pleased god to bless me with I give & dispose of
in the manner and form following Vizt Item I desire all my just
debts to be paid by my Execut. Item give and bequeath unto my beloved
daughter Mary Boyd the land and Plantation wheron I now live
which I purchased of one Holloway & half the lands I purchased of
Joel Cheatwood also the one half of all my Negroes Vizt One Sarah
Dico Hannah Joshua Sam and Kate also the one half of all my Stock
of all Kinds and the one half of my houseto and Kitchen furniture to the said
hers forever Item I give and bequeath unto my beloved son William Boyd
the tract of Land I bought of Elisha Keen formerly belong^d to Peter Gillon
and other half of the same I bought of Joel Cheatwood also the one
half of my Negroes as above mentioned Vizt - One Sarah Dico Hannah
Joshua Sam and Pete also the one half of my Stock of all Kinds and the
other half of my house to and Kitchen furniture to him and heirs
forever Item also the money due me to be Collected & Equally
Divided between my two Children Vizt Mary Boyd and William
Boyd. Item my will and desire after my death is that my Negro
man Sam shall have his freedom after his paying my two children
Vizt - Mary Boyd and William Boyd forty pounds one half in Cash
the other half in trade to be Equally Divided between my two above
mentioned children, Lastly I appoint my beloved son William Boyd Executor
to this my last Will and Testament in the manner & form as above mentioned
