to wit, I leave and bequeath to my beloved Wife Mary Thorp
her Lawfull dower of all my Estate both Real & Personal
during her Natural life and at her decease to return to my
Estate & to be divided Amongst my three Children in the
Manner and form as is hereafter directed I give and
bequeath unto my Son William Thorp one Moiety of all my
Estate both Real & Personal I also give and bequeath to my two
Daughters Elizabeth & Polly the other Moiety to be Equally divided,
Between them when they Arrive to the Age of twenty five years
to be paid by my Son William and that the said Estate shall
be under the direction of my Executors until my Daughter Elizabeth
& Polly shall Receive their Moiety of my Estate as is here devised
I also desire that my Executors pay unto Sarah Star out of my
Estate at her Arriving to the age of Eighteen years five pounds
Current And I also appoint Swinfield Hite & Samuel Hairston
my Sole Executors of my last will & Testament, and I do hereby
utterly disallow Revoke disannul all and every other former
Testament Wills legacies bequests and Executors by me in any
wise before named Wills and bequeathed Ratifying and
Confirming this and No other to be my last will and Testament
in Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal
this twenty first day January in the year of our Lord one thousand
seven hundred and ninety four
