buried in a Christian like manner at the discretion of my Executor not depriv-
ing her of the generall Resurrection I shall leave the same again by the
mighty power of God and as touching my worldly Estate whatsoever God
blessed me I give devise and dispose of the same in the following man-
ner and form First I give to my daughter Anna M^e mother born of my
own body one half of my goods Breath and reasonable and likeways my
whole apparel to be delivered to her by her Executor by right here-
after my devise to the proper use and behof of her in the administration her exec-
utors Administrators and assigns for ever.

And I do hereby appoint nominate and constitute my Surefector
Frances Elborn born of my own body my Sole Executor of this my last Will
and Testament and I do hereby disallow revoke and disannull all and every
former Wills Testaments legacies bequests and Executors by me
made before named willed said bequests and Executors to be
to be my last Will and Testament to witness whereof I have hereunto set
my hand and Seal this day and year above written

bear her last Will and Testament.
