And I do hereby utterly disallow, revoke & disannul all
every other former Testaments Wills Executors by me,
in any ways before this time named Willed & bequeathed
ratifying & confirming this & no other to be my last Will
(and Testament in all things) which I have hereunto set
my hand & seal the Day & year above Written
