 at the day of Resurrection I shall revive to the same life & life of glory
 of God & as touching such Worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased
 God to bless me in this life I give & dispose of the same in
 the following manner & Form

I have given bequeath unto Elizabeth my dearly beloved Wife
 hereafter forever one half of my Worldly Estate when I shall be
 dead and my Ordain my only & sole executor of this my last Will &
 Testament

From I give to my well beloved son Peter McGinnis the other half
part of my worldly Estate to him & his Assigns for ever but in case
he should die before he comes to the Age of sixteen years his share
shall be Delivered to the next of Kin to me.

From Jimmy Hill. I believe that if we could

have unto my Trusty & well beloved friend William Bayan
that then it shall be lawful for the said William Bayan to sue
for the said part & Money of my said son whom I appoint guardian
of my said son after my said death. Witness my hand & seal the 10th day of
