39th Deeds of Patine land together with all the buildings and improve-
ments and Appurtenances thereto belonging in which I give and
demise unto the proper use and behoof of him his heirs and assigns forever
I shewly I give and demise unto my two daughters Susanna and Mary
my small trunk and two small books with my worn wearing apparel
which are not to be sold but equally divided between them And all
the rest of my personal Estate to be sold and equally divided between
my three daughters Susanna Mary and Ann Nickline Lastly I ordain
and constitute my two friends and esteemed friends John Millbourn
and John Briscoe sole Executors of this my last will and Testament
