IN THE NAME OF GOD AMEN, I Robert McKee of Frederick County and State of Virginia being old and weak in body but of a perfect Mind and memory, blessed be God for the same, Do this forth day of June one thousand seven hundred ninety two, make and ordain this my last will and testament in writing that is to say first of all I give and recommend my soul in hands of the almighty God that gave it and my body the earth to be buried in desent Christian burial at the discretion of my Executors, nothing doubting but at the generall resurection I shall receive the same again by the mighty power of God, and as tuching such worldly Estate wherewith it has pleased God to bless me with, I give and devise in the following manner and form first, I Give and bequeth unto my well beloved doughter Mary Hock the sum of five shillings Virginia Money to be raised and levied out of my Estate at my deseas, Second I Give and bequeth unto my well beloved son William a small parcel of land lying on Isaacs Creek adjoining John Not marked by my own hand below his present Ressedence and bounded by legal lines on three sides. Thirdly I give unto my well beloved Son John five Shillings Virginia money to be rasid and levied out of my Estate at my decease, fourthly I give and bequeth to my well beloved doughter Margeret Fisher five shillings Virginia money to be raised and levied out of my Estate at my decease. Fitty I give to my well beloved sons Robert, Josep & Barthollowmeu my plantation whereon I now live to be equally devized between them, but in Case of my decease, before my youngest sons becom of age, the one of age to possess it without its profits giving a sutable schooling. To the youngest at the arrival of Josepaph at the age of twenty one he enjoys the half to the youngest becom of age. I Sixth Give to my well beloved doughter yet Infant Jane, Anne, Elisebeth & Sarah ten pounds Virginia money to be rasid and levied out of my Estate
